

Modern Foreign Languages

At Grayshott Primary School, we believe that the learning of an additional language provides a valuable educational, social and cultural experience for pupils. It helps the children to develop communication skills, extend their knowledge of how language works and gives them an additional perspective on the world. Spanish is the main Modern Foreign Language taught in Key Stage 2. The lessons are delivered by class teachers who are supported by a subject lead who is a specialist MFL teacher. Children develop and progress in the 5 key language skills necessary for learning Spanish: Speaking, Listening, Reading, Writing and Grammar. Each lesson has a clear, achievable objective and incorporates a multi- sensory approach to learning.

The Spanish Curriculum Map for 2023-2024 is attached below. Where topics are repeated, more complex vocabulary/questions/conversations are added progressively each term/year.
