Parent Survey – November 2022

Thank you so much for taking part in our parent survey last week. Here are the results, with comparisons to the last survey done in June 2021. The percentages are those who 'strongly agreed' or 'agreed' with the statements.

Therefore, I wonder if they were disagreeing with the fact that their child had been bullied, as opposed to the way it was dealt with.
