

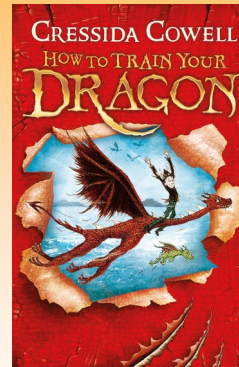
# Vikings

## Green Class Summer 2

### English

Green class will start by further developing their persuasive writing skills. Inspired by exemplar texts and film clips from Gladiator and Braveheart, they will write their own battle cry. Following this, Green class will write their own 'how to' chapter based on Cressida Cowell's 'How To Train Your Dragon' book.

During their reading lessons, Green class will hone their comprehension, prediction, summarising and inference skills by reading excerpts from a variety of books including Vikings in 30 seconds.



### Science

During their 'Living Things' unit, Green class will consider the question 'What is classification?' The children will start by classifying living things, they will then look at life cycles and consider how environmental change affects habitats.

### DT

In design technology, Green class will plan, prepare and evaluate a healthy picnic lunch for themselves. They will also apply their understanding of electrical circuits when they design and make a flashlight.

### History

Our focus will be on the Vikings. Through historical enquiry, Green class will try to answer the question: Vikings: raiders or traders?

### Spanish

Pupils will learn ten flavours of ice-cream and the transactional language required to purchase an ice-cream in Spanish.

### Maths

Year 4 will start by comparing, estimating and calculating money. They will then look at time, shape and position and direction.

Throughout this time, Green class will work on arithmetic skills and multiplication tables knowledge.

### Geography

Green class will look at settlements. They will consider the needs early settlers had when choosing a place to build a home. They will look at place names around the UK to see how the Anglo-Saxons, Romans and Vikings all left their mark. They will design their own new settlement.

### PSHE

Through our Jigsaw scheme of learning, Green class will look at friendships and will cover the 'Changing Me' unit.

### RE

Green class will consider how different people describe god.
