#### **Our Curriculum Aspirations for the term:**

##### **Personal, social and emotional:** Relationships (Jigsaw)

#### **Our core texts are:**

Ten Seeds by Ruth Brown



We will continue our daily phonics sessions where we teach the children the skills they need to read. We will be working through level 4 of the Twinkl DfE approved phonics scheme.

The children will be continuing to complete their challenges each day as well as have lots of chances to apply their skills during 'busy time'.



We will be planting sunflower seeds and taking care of them with the hope they grow into sunflowers.



We will be getting changed for PE in school this term. Children will need to bring in a named draw string bag with their P.E kit. This includes:
