## History

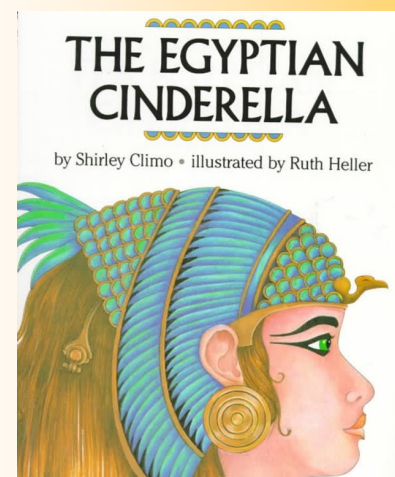
Green class pupils will discover what daily life was like in Ancient Egypt. They will consider questions such as: Why was the river Nile so important to daily life? How do artefacts help us to understand what life was like? What did Ancient Egyptians believe? On 17 November, Green class will take part in a workshop led by an expert from Haslemere Museum, where they will have a chance to ask questions and to handle artefacts to deepen their historical understanding.



## English

During this half term, Green class will read 'The Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo. They will have a chance to compose a diary entry in role and to update the story by writing their own version.

In guided reading, the children will read and discuss a variety of texts, including excerpts from the story of 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown.



## Maths

This half-term, we will be turning our attention to the following topics: addition and subtraction, measurement (area) and multiplication.

## Science

Pupils will look at food groups and find out how humans digest food.

## RE

In RE this half term, the children will consider the concept of neighbour, with particular reference to the Christian religion.

## Spanish

The children will practise language relating to the seasons and they will find out how Christmas is celebrated in Spain.

## PSHE
