Addition and subtraction

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) equals (=) signs.
 - Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20.
- Add and subtract 1-digit & 2-digit numbers to 20, including zero.

Place Value

- Count to and across 50, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number.
 - Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens.
 - Given a number, identify one more and one less.
 - Identify & represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line.
- Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.

Traditional Tales

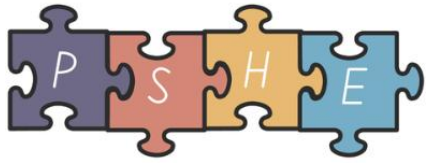


Key text: Jack and the Beanstalk
