Computing: Sequencing sounds using Scratch

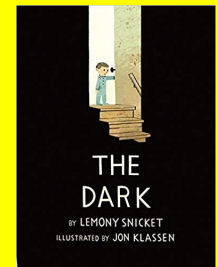
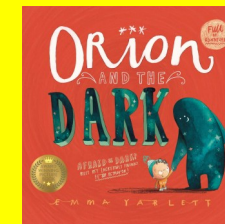
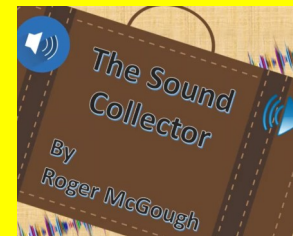
Spanish: Animals, colours and nouns

Who's Afraid of the Dark?

Our topic for this spring term centres around our learning of light in Science.

The children will learn to identify different light sources and explain what happens to make a shadow. They will use scientific terms to describe what happens to the way shadows change and identify patterns in results. The children will make observations and take measurements and record their findings as a bar chart.
