

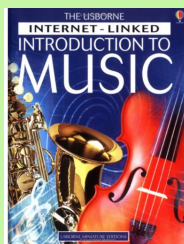
Sound

Our learning journey this half term will be inspired by the science of sound. Green class will investigate sound and focus in on music. They will find out about different types of music, musical instruments and composers. They will also listen as they tell each other their own stories based on traditional African oral stories. In addition, Green class pupils will continue to learn their chosen musical instrument.

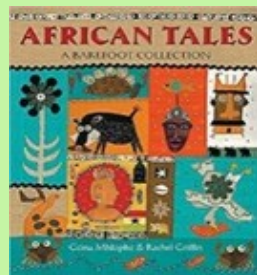


English

Using non fiction texts, Green class will create their own information text about an instrument of their choice for display.



In addition, Green class will write and tell their own stories in the style of a traditional African Anansi story which is told out loud.



During whole class reading lessons, Green class will read books and texts that are structured in different ways focussing on interesting non fiction texts.

Science

Green class children will endeavour to answer our big question: How is sound produced? They will undertake investigations and experiments to support them in their understanding of how sounds are made; how sound travels; what is pitch and volume and which materials are best for soundproofing.

Maths

This half term, Green class children will focus on formal and informal written methods for multiplication and division. In measurement, they will investigate length and perimeter. They will also start their fractions learning journey. Please continue to support your child with their learning of their times tables facts and with their regular use of our TT Rockstars resource.
