

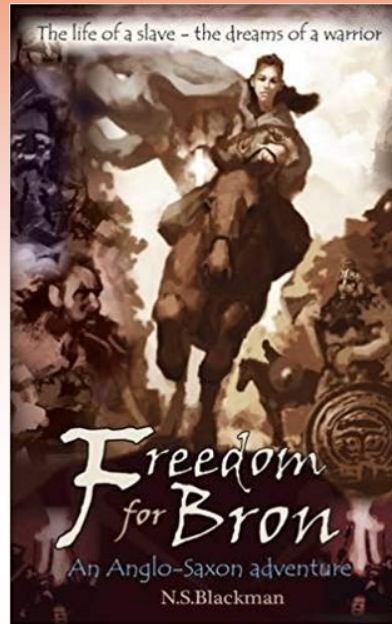
Why did the Anglo Saxons come to Britain?

Green Class Summer 1

English

For the first half of the summer term Green class will be using the novel 'Freedom For Bron' by N.S Blackman to inspire and influence their writing. They will be looking at understanding and describing the characters found in this Anglo-Saxon adventure story.

During their reading lessons, Green class will enjoy reading and understanding a variety of fiction and non fiction texts, including chapters from 'Coming to England', the inspiring text by Floella Benjamin.



Science

Green class will continue their unit on Electricity. They will be able to troubleshoot and identify whether or not a bulb will light in a simple series circuit and be able to identify a complete circuit. The children will also learn about conductors and insulators and know that metals are very good electrical conductors.

DT

DT lessons will focus on nutrition and healthy eating. The children will identify what makes a healthy lunch in order to design, make and evaluate a type of sandwich which can be part of a healthy picnic lunch for a Green class student.

History

Green class will study the on Anglo-Saxons. They will investigate where they originated from, why they migrated to Britain and how they changed Britain. This topic will be complemented by our visit to Butser Ancient Farm, where Green class will have the opportunity to experience activities which will enable them to understand what daily life was like during Anglo Saxon times.

Maths

During the first half of the summer term, Year 4 will be introduced to decimals: comparing decimals, rounding decimals, recognising decimals equivalents and finding the effect of dividing a one or two digit number by 10 or 100. Following this, they will learn to compare, estimate and calculate money. Throughout this time, they will work on arithmetic skills, as well as revising their times tables knowledge in readiness for the national Multiplication Tables Check.

Spanish

Green class will start by taking part in role-play activities to buy different quantities of vegetables. They will then apply their language skills to the purchase of different flavoured ice-creams.

PSHE

Through the Jigsaw Relationships unit, Green class will look at building positive relationships.

RE

Green class will consider stones as symbols as they apply to Christianity.
