Our topic for this summer term will invite children to further enhance their knowledge of the natural world with a focus on the amazing animals of planet Earth!

As part of our learning in **English**, the children will be writing their own poem in the style of Angela McCallister from the book *Wild World*. In our second learning journey, we will use the book *We Travel So Far* to help us not only research some of these animals but also learn how to use a wide range of writing techniques that will help produce entertaining and informative commentary on some extraordinary creatures.

Maths: This half-term, we will be turning our attention to the following maths topics:

- Shape
- Position and direction
- Decimals
- Negative numbers
- Converting units
- Volume



Science: The children will be learning about animals and their habitats.

RE: The children will learn about the meaning of 'sacred' and explore sacred places of worship across different faiths.

Music: The children will be looking into music from musical theatre and have a go at creating their own musical.

PE: Dodgeball and Cricket (CM Sports)

PSHE: The children will be learning about online relationships and how to stay safe online.

Geography: The children will be learning about mountains including how they are formed as well as how we can find them on maps.

Computing: Children will learn how to use programming to create a vector drawing.

Spanish: The children will continue to learn language surrounding clothes and start discussing the weather.
