### Red Class



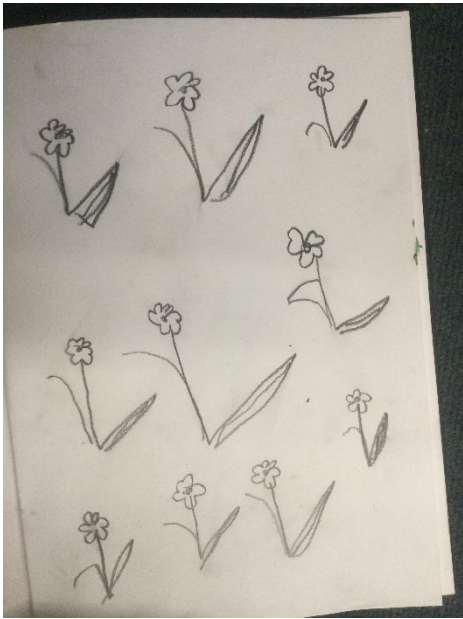
**Red Class** have been working on their counting skills this week, making their own number lines using number shapes. They have also been experimenting with different painting techniques and building a beanstalk.

In Art, they have been drawing flowers, taking care to study their subject in detail. Here is Arthur's.

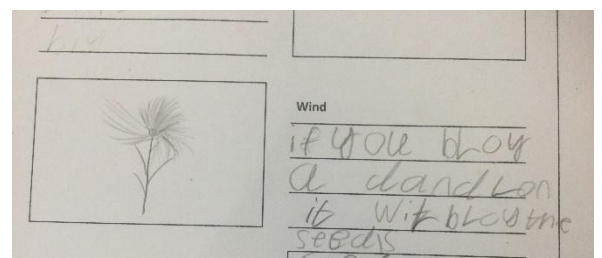
## Blue Class

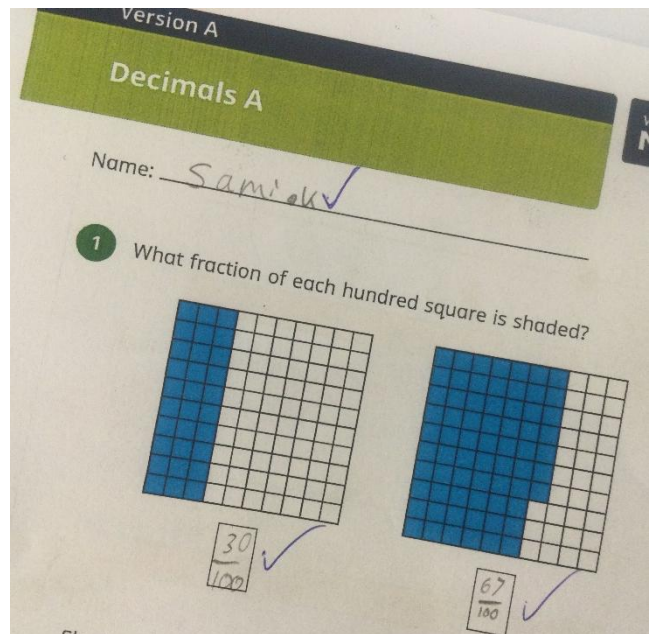


## Green Class

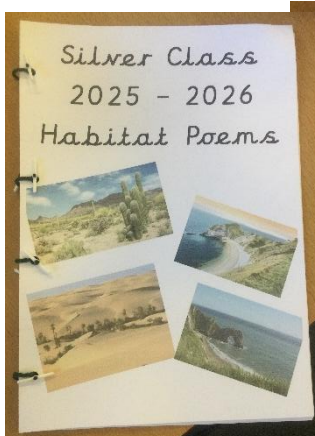

Here's two marks for Sami!

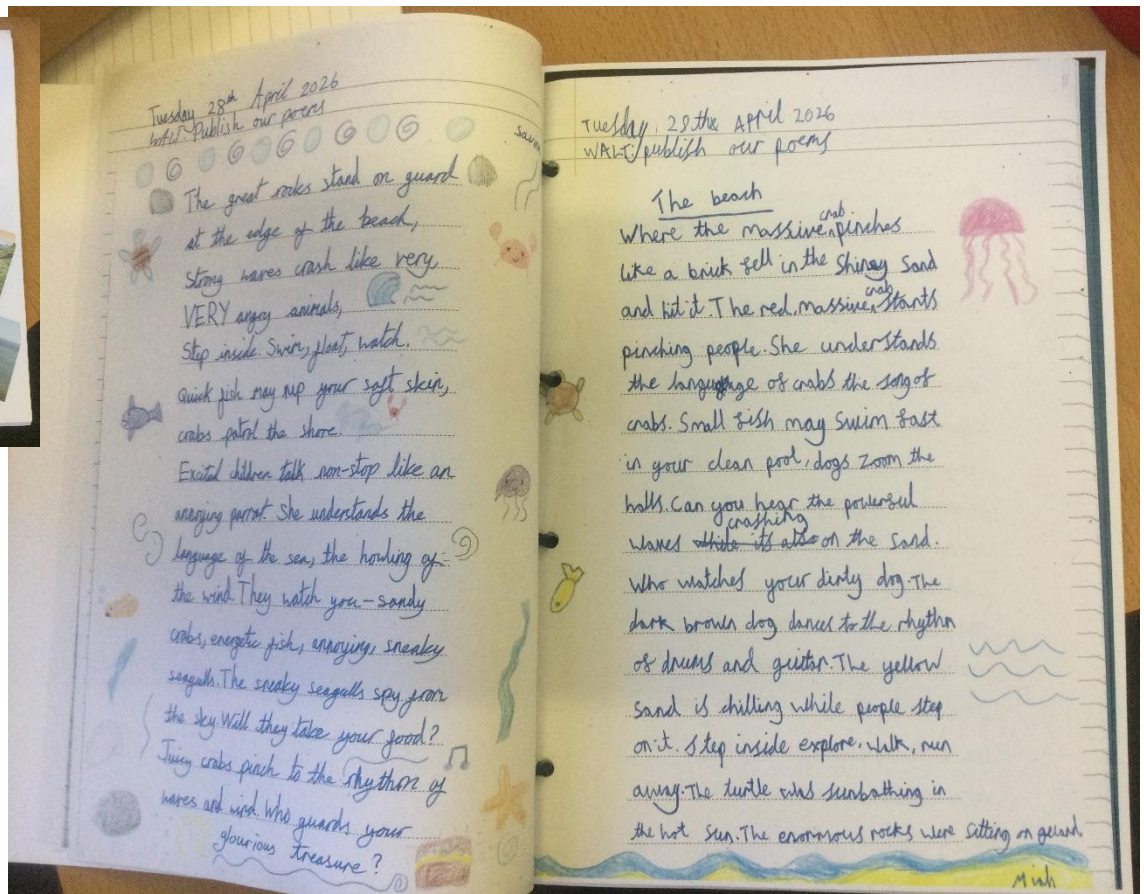


## Silver Class
