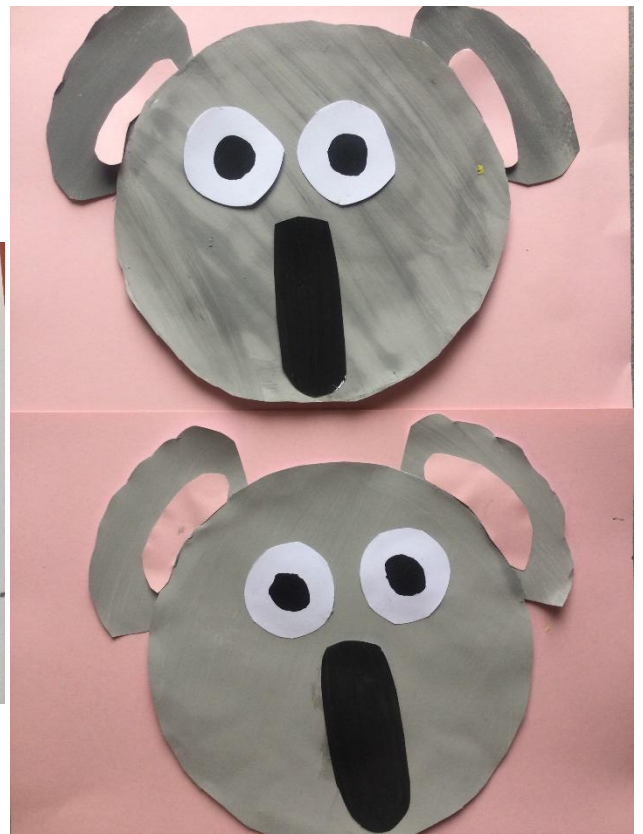
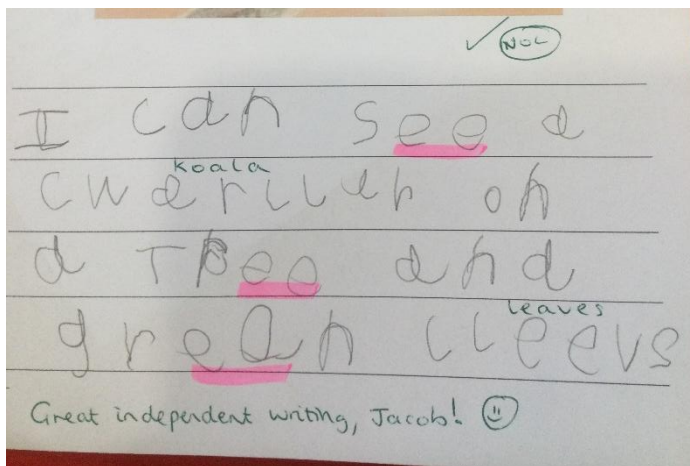
Sports Day

Red Class

Red Class are learning about the book 'The Koala Who Could' so today they have done writing and made their own koalas. This is independent writing from Jacob M. The children are focusing on saying sentences aloud before they write them and using finger spaces between words.



Yellow Class



Yellow Class planted their own sunflower seeds this week and are doing a great job at checking and watering them. They have also started using Scratch on the Ipads to create their own animations. They have also started the Daily Mile this week which the children have loved.

Next week, children will be learning how to write their own instructions to make a horrible sandwich. They will also be doing some taste testing in D & T as research for making our own fruit kebabs!

Blue Class



Blue Class have been discussing where they live, finding the county, closest town and city on a map. They have been starting to plan a set of instructions (How to grow a ...) and in RE they have been discussing when they might think about God. The children did well on their first week of the "Daily Mile." In maths, they are continuing working on fractions, finding the whole from a part and using a bar model to represent different fractions.

In DT, they have been carrying on their work on wheels and axles, making their own moving toys.



Purple Class

Purple Class during English, will be using dictionaries to find the meanings of tricky technical vocabulary linked to *Cracking Contraptions* by Wallace and Gromit. They will continue to develop their understanding of a text by exploring its structure, vocabulary and grammar features in greater detail. After learning how the Snoozatron works, the children will discuss and record ideas for their own contraptions, thinking carefully about their purpose and how they operate. They will then use these ideas to plan and begin writing a similar explanation text. In Maths, they will continue learning about mass. The children will find equivalent masses, compare and order masses, and solve a variety of problems involving mass. They will be encouraged to apply their understanding through practical activities and reasoning tasks to deepen their confidence with this topic.

Green Class



Green Class wrote postcards in their History lesson in the role of a young Viking who set sail on a long boat to Britain. They combined creativity and facts in their postcards, which was a delight to see. They also recapped their understanding of the main food groups in readiness for their DT cooking project. Next week, **Green Class** will start the shape unit in maths, by understanding angles as turns. On Friday, they hope to make and evaluate the sandwiches they have designed in DT.

Silver Class

This week, **Silver Class** have learnt all about negative numbers in maths, learning how to order and compare them as well as find the difference between them. In English, they have continued to learn skills to help them write a setting description.

Next week they will start creating moving pictures using gears based on their designs that were made this week. They will also be having a computing workshop where the children will learn how to code a robot.

Gold Class

Gold Class have completed their 'I am made from' poems which are really impressive. In maths, they solved the decatree puzzle (amongst others) and in science they made pledges to take small steps towards playing their part in slowing climate change. Most of the week has been learning lines, actions for songs and stage directions. When not rehearsing, they have been sign making and things are looking really good for the fair after school on **Friday 19th June**. They can start bringing in prizes and equipment anytime next week for us to store in the annex to our classroom.

Next week, they are off to the Cathedral on Thursday for the Leavers' Service. Please make sure that **Gold Class** re all wearing full school uniform and have a packed lunch even though it is a PE day! They will also be continuing with their Design Technology which includes designing, creating, sewing and applique. The tote bags are going to be a fantastic keepsake and memory of their time at Grayshott. Just a reminder that Leavers' hoodies can be worn to school from Friday 19th June onwards.
