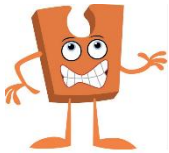


Computing

Maths

- Count to 20 forwards and backwards, beginning with any 0 or 1, or from any number
- Read and write numbers from 1-20 in numerals and words
- Locate numbers on a number line and identify one less and one more.
- Number bonds to 10
- Develop understanding of addition and subtraction

Art

- Use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination
- Use natural materials such as leaves and sticks to make collages and sculptures.
- Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.

Handball:

- **Show control of the ball whilst passing, throwing and catching**
- **Pass the ball so it is difficult for someone to intercept**

Dance:

- Move confidently and safely in their own space, using changes of speed, level and direction
- Perform movement phrases using a range of different body actions and body parts
